INDIGENOUS FEMALE LEADERSHIP AWARD



The Women in Resources Northern Territory Awards form part of the Australian resources sector's strategies to promote the benefits of increasing the participation of women at all levels.

They recognise, promote and celebrate the achievements of women, men and companies who make outstanding contributions toward a more diverse workforce.

The sector recognises that diversity not only helps to ensure it has the skilled employees it needs but also improves business outcomes via the proven benefits of a more inclusive and gender balanced workforce.

The Winner from each Award Category will be automatically nominated for the Women in Resources National Awards.

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AWARD CATEGORY

INDIGENOUS FEMALE LEADERSHIP AWARD

This award category recognises exceptional achievements of leadership in the resources sector in any occupation from an indigenous woman. It notes her leadership skills, resilience, her methods of overcoming barriers and seeking out and accepting new responsibilities and challenges. It also notes her record of encouraging and mentoring other women in the resources sector and her efforts towards building gender diversity within the sector. This award also recognises her contribution to her community, and/or resources communities with which she has a connection particularly in helping secure the industry's social license to operate.

We are seeking applications from women who:

- ☉ *work in the resources in the Northern Territory*
- ☉ *have made a significant contribution to their organisation/company and/or the resources sector*
- ☉ *have made a direct or indirect contribution to the advancement of women in resources through being a role model/mentor or through leadership*
- ☉ *have made a difference to society through the resources sector, such as contributed to social/community development*
- ☉ *have broken new ground for women in the resources sector*

- ☉ enclose a digital photograph of you at work (close-up is best) at high resolution (300dpi or greater) (do not embed within a document)

- ☉ applications close COB on Friday 1 May 2015
- ☉ applications are invited from people working in all areas of the Northern Territory mining, oil & gas, civil construction and transport & logistics sectors
- ☉ applicants do not have to work for a company that is a member of any representative body
- ☉ finalists are invited to attend the presentation of the awards at the Inaugural Awards Dinner in Darwin on 30 May 2015. Finalists will need to make their own arrangements to travel to Darwin; however employer support in this matter is usually forthcoming. If unable to attend finalists are asked to have someone represent them at the dinner
- ☉ applications will not be accepted unless accompanied by a signed entry form. Signed forms may be scanned and e-mailed or contain an electronic signature.
- ☉ applicants should be aware that section winners will play an ambassadorial role for the

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following 12 months and may be requested to speak at or attend events.

- ☉ applications can be made on behalf of another person, so long as the candidate has knowledge of the application
- ☉ preferred format for entries is this form, or a pdf document
- ☉ photographs should be sent separately as a high resolution JPEG file (300dpi or greater). Close-up photos of you at work are preferred. By entering, candidates agree for these photos to be used in promotional materials for the awards and other promotional materials. Do not embed photos in documents, send as separate attachment.
- ☉ prizes: Prizes are a commemorative trophy and nomination into the National Women in Resources Awards under the category of Exceptional Women in Resources as there is currently no separate award for Indigenous Female Leadership .
